
Duis Center updates shine

42-year-old rec facility gets a \$3.5M facelift

STERLING – The Sterling Park District's Frank R. Duis Recreation Center has a new look and a modern sensibility.

Inside and out, the facility at 211 E. St. Mary's Road has undergone a \$3.5 million renovation, the first major remodeling since it was built 42 years ago.

Inside the two-story facility, an elevator has been installed and the lobby has been completely redesigned, and now sports a sleek new registration desk.

The locker rooms, fitness center, multipurpose room, staff offices and restrooms have been updated, and viewing areas for the refurbished pool and the gym have been added.
